Reporting to the alarm centre

Remain calm!

Call the emergency number:

Report the accident:

Who is reporting the fault?

Where did it happen?

What happened?

When did it happen?

How many people were injured?

Wait for further instructions or queries!

If necessary, perform first aid:

- Secure the accident site
- Care for the injured person(s)
- Follow operational personnel instructions

In the event of a gas alarm (NH_3 , H_2S , PH_3 , CO):

- Close all doors and windows
- Switch off ventilation
- Follow operational personnel instructions

In the event of a fire:

- Attempt to extinguish fire from safe distance
- If necessary, ensure there is an outlet for smoke
- Find an assembly point by following the escape routes (see the site plan)
- Do not use any lifts (risk of suffocation)
- Follow operational personnel instructions

Our culture of safety

Work safety – Count me in!

We, the employees and managers of the AGR group at the RZR Herten plant encourage and expect safety-conscious working and conduct at our plants. We recognise the value of health and safety for ourselves, our customers and partner companies and we commit ourselves to adhering to the following basic principles:

1. Together, we all accept responsibility for safety and health protection.
2. We consider safe working to be an indicator of our high quality service.
3. We comply with safety regulations while protecting ourselves and others.
4. We are open to improvements and continue to further develop our culture of safety.
5. We communicate the importance of safety to all groups and individuals involved.



Safety at RZR Herten

The RZR Herten waste-to-energy power plant is an important site for the appropriate and professional disposal of waste and equally for the production of electricity and district heating in our region. Here, residential, commercial and industrial waste is thermally treated around the clock, 365 days a year.

Safety is of the utmost importance at RZR Herten – during operation of the plant as well as when dealing with delivered waste.

During your visit to our industrial plant, please note the following information and regulations.

General regulations

- The German Highway Code (StVO) applies to vehicle traffic. The permissible **maximum speed throughout the site is 15 km/h.**
- **Trespassing on the RZR site is prohibited.** An access or transit permit is required. The instructions of AGR employees or company management must be followed.
- **Smoking, fire and open flames are prohibited** throughout the entire **site.** Specially marked converted rooms and spaces are exempt. Alcohol and drug consumption are prohibited **throughout the entire site.**
- **People with pacemakers and active medical implants are prohibited** from entering the **areas marked accordingly on the site plan.**
- **Work regulations are to be observed.**



- In the plant facility, it is **mandatory to wear a helmet and high visibility vest behind the weighing machine.**



- **AGR employee instructions must be followed.**

Suppliers

- Waste **suppliers** are permitted to enter the area of plant **behind the weighing machine.**
- Security officer and personnel **instructions must be observed.**

Commercial and private waste suppliers

- Access **is only** possible via **the weighing machine.**
- The **instructions** of personnel in charge of the weighing machine and the unloading area **must be observed.**
- Always pay attention to order and cleanliness.

Visitors to RZR Herten

- You must report to the security officer and specify your contact person in order to gain access to the plant facility. There, you will be given a **visitor's badge** (if you're part of a group, only the group leader will be given one) **which must be clearly visible.** The visitor's badge does not give you authorisation to access the plant facility! You must be accompanied by an authorised RZR employee.
- If you take part in a tour, it is mandatory to **wear a helmet, high visibility clothing and safety goggles in some areas of the site.** This equipment will be provided for you.
- Removing yourself from a **visitor group** or **leaving the approved visitor route is prohibited.**
- Wear **sturdy shoes** (no open toe shoes or shoes with high heels).
- Consuming **food or drinks** is prohibited in the **plant facility.**
- **Video and audio recording as well as photography is only permitted with approval** granted by AGR company management.

Occupational safety at the RZR Herten waste-to-energy power plant

- **To access the plant facility** you must be **accompanied by an authorised RZR employee** or be in the possession of a **special work permit** and had a **briefing from your responsible construction manager.**
- **Within the scope of executing work, it is important to observe** the regulations of the **institutions for statutory accident insurance and prevention** in conjunction with **plant regulations** and the **mandatory signs displayed throughout the plant.**
- **All occupational accidents must be recorded in the first aid book.**

While working at RZR Herten, please use personal protective equipment in accordance with regulations. Tools and personal protective equipment are not provided by AGR.



- **All edges, floor openings, excavation pits, ditches and scaffolding must be secured on the site grounds.**
- **On the site grounds, you must only use the safe traffic routes.**
- **Site visitors are not permitted to operate the factory equipment.**
- **Hazardous areas** of machines and loads **must be avoided** (components and loads must be secured from toppling over and falling down) and the **working area must be kept clear** (prevent trip hazards).
- **The work area must be secured against the risk of fire.** Safe working must also be ensured in areas at risk of explosion hazards (clearance measurements, explosion-proof tools/equipment).
- Attachment points for **personal protective equipment against falls** must be established.
- **All necessary work equipment must be available, checked and in perfect working order.**
